**This last year brought many changes to the Prescott Valley Parks and Recreation, Arts and Culture, and the Library. In September 2021, these departments merged into a super department called Community Services. This hasn't been an easy task. We did considerable restructuring in both departments to ensure balanced leadership.**

As we were pushing through the details, before COVID, the Parks and Recreation Department, just finished their 2020 Master Plan. Based on this cohesive plan, and community input, strategies are in place to enhance our programming offerings and special events. We have an amazing young team in Parks and Recreation who have a passion for helping people improve their quality of life. We have big plans! In September, we plan to open a splash pad in Antelope Park, including pickleball courts. We will unveil the Jenkins Obelisk sculpture, by artist Ed Reilly, and Flora and Fauna sculpture, by artist Tom White. We are working on providing more arts

and cultural events, food festivals, programs for teens, expanding our adult and youth sports leagues and classes, and youth day camps next summer. others in the community who were without. Just this month, the library received over seven Library Services Technology Act grants (LSTA), plus an American Rescue Plan Allocations grant. Not a lot of people know that libraries throughout the United States rely on grant funding through the Institute of Museums and Library Services (IMLS), which includes LSTA grants. IMLS was established in 1996 to support libraries and museums to sustain lifelong learning and cultural heritage. These funds allow libraries to promote early literacy, digital literacy, STEM, art, inclusive and accessible learning, innovation, and critical thinking. One of the largest grants will be used to create

a "Tween Space," which focuses on kids between the ages of 9-13. During our community assessment, this was a service gap we weren't addressing. Our middle schoolers use our library but feel out of place in the Children's area and are too young for our Teen area. We are excited to order materials, furniture, and other cool gear for our Tweens and give them their own space and programming to continue their library journey with us.

I believe our new super department will be able to hit on all aspects of our community's needs from education, improve quality of life, promote economic development, support small businesses, and be



a center for the arts. I couldn't be prouder of the staff we have and their passion and skills to fulfill all those needs.

# UNITED ANIMAL FRIENDS ON A RESCUE MISSION

After finding new homes for thousands of homeless cats and dogs over the past 18 years, United Animal Friends (UAF) has finally found a home of its own. Thanks to a very generous bequest from the estate of local animal lover Margaret Stidworthy, UAF has been able to purchase an ideal property in Prescott. The shaded 2.3-acre site, which they are calling the "Rescue Ranch," includes a house, casita and barn, and has enough additional space for a future shelter for dogs and cats. The property is centrally located for the convenience of UAF volunteers and adopters coming from anywhere in the Quad City area, and is adjacent to the Peavine Trail, which will allow volunteer dog walkers to exercise pups who will be staying at the property.

While the bequest from Mrs. Stidworthy enabled UAF to purchase the property, the organization is seeking donations to help build the shelter and to maximize the potential of the property until the shelter can be built. In addition to monetary donations, the organization's current needs include gravel for the driveway and parking area, no-climb fencing, concrete to finish the daytime dog runs, and corrugated steel or other material that can be used for privacy fencing. Also needed is a person with welding equipment and experience to build framework for stainless steel kennels, which the group already has.

Arielle Mason, a Phoenix-based architectural designer, is drafting the building plans free of charge to help the organization. Other businesses have also donated or provided services at a reduced fee, such as Neumann High Country Garage Doors, who installed doors on the formerly doorless barn; Hubb Contracting LLC, who framed up the door openings, cleaned up the property and performed numerous other improvements;

and ArrowSeal, who helped with heating and cooling needs. UAF is extremely grateful for this support, as every dollar saved on property improvements and building costs can go toward helping animals in need.

Making the shelter a reality will take time and a major fundraising campaign, but UAF is making good use of the property in the meantime. In addition to serving as a central location for storage of equipment and pet food, the Rescue Ranch is being used for board meetings, volunteer gatherings and fundraisers, such as their recent "Down for Dogs" yoga fundraiser on the shaded lawn. An on-site manager is living in the house and will be fostering dogs and

cats in the house and casita until the shelter is built.

Since 2003, dedicated UAF volunteers have been fostering dogs and cats in their homes, but there simply are not enough fosters to accommodate the number of animals who are at risk of being euthanized in overcrowded shelters. In order to save as many as possible, UAF pays for boarding in local veterinary clinics and boarding facilities until they are adopted, or a foster becomes available. While fostering will remain UAF's primary focus, having a shelter facility will allow them to have a more personal

relationship with the dogs and cats who don't have a foster, so they can better assess and address their needs. Having the ability to spend more time with each animal will result in even better matches between pets and adopters.

United Animal Friends is volunteer based 501(c)3 nonprofit group founded in 2003. The organization


has found loving homes for more than 6,000 cats and dogs through its Adoption Program, helped spay or neuter more than 20,000 through its various Spay/ Neuter Programs, distributed more than 400,000 pounds of food to clients who otherwise could not afford to feed their pets through its Community Pet Food Bank, and paid for emergency veterinary services for over a thousand community pets through its Emergency Medical Program. After 18 years of serving the community without a central location, the

rescue is very excited about this new chapter in their story.

United Animal Friends' mission is to provide rescue programs and services to animals and those who care for them. Its primary goals are saving the lives of adoptable dogs and cats; finding the best home for each animal in its care; reducing pet overpopulation through its spay/ neuter programs; feeding hungry animals through its Community Pet Food Bank; and relieving suffering and facilitating the compassionate treatment of animals.

# ANIMAL ENRICHMENT: RETHINKING

When you think of a dog toy, what comes to mind? Is it a tennis ball, a squeaky toy shaped like some other animal, or a simple rope? There is no doubt the pet retailers have plenty to choose from. In my experience, it does not take much to entertain my dog - a football with a squeaker in the middle is just fine for her to play fetch with. The problem is, as we know, fetch requires a person to throw the ball. Since I work in an office, on days that I bring my energetic young dog with me to work, I want to give her something to do in between outside breaks that might not exactly require my attention. Just like giving a tablet to a child, there are ways to keep your dog occupied, simultaneously offering a mind-enriching experience that is about more than just keeping them busy.

There are plenty of toys and puzzles that are available to purchase for ready-to-go enrichment. Toys are available for all stages of a dog's life - for the pups who like to chew, cuddle, or prefer food rewards. Here are a couple of my personal favorites:

**Snuffle Mats** - Typically an array of tassels that you can hide small treats and kibble inside. It requires your dog to seek out the food reward, much like scatter feeding. This is not ideal for dogs that like to chew stuff up! You do not want them to shred or ingest the fabric of a snuffle mat.

**Licking Pads** - These have different levels of "difficulty" and can be filled with wet food, peanut butter, and other food dogs love. Freeze it and let your dog lick away! This is a great exercise for dogs with anxiety to keep their minds busy during times like bath-time or nail trimming.



**Treat-Stuffed Toys** - Some puzzles allow you to put individual pieces of kibble or small treats into something like a ball, and your dog has to line up holes or move pieces around in order to receive the food reward.



As an anti-drug organization, MATFORCE volunteers and staff are the boots-on-the-ground when it comes to youth substance use prevention in Yavapai County. Consequently, we hear the real-life stories from the community, often before it reaches the media. We take these stories as seriously as we do the annual data that comes from State and National agencies because we understand that for every data point there is a human story.

This is very much the case in our latest education and public awareness campaign on fentanyl.

Working closely with the Overdose Fatality Review Board (OFRB), MATFORCE has kept a running total of fentanyl overdose deaths in our county since 2016. As of June 2021, that number totaled almost 60 people.

MATFORCE Executive Director Merilee Fowler spoke about this alarming trend. "This number represents our children, spouse, friends, and coworkers. It is heartbreaking to hear of even one person losing their life to substance use. It is unconscionable to know that almost 60 people in our community have lost their lives to fentanyl, and that 10 of those are teens."



2018 was the first year that the OFRB recorded an overdose death of someone younger than 20 years old. Since then, ten teens have died from a fentanyl overdose. Two of those deaths were 14-year-olds.

As alarming as this trend is, our community leaders have already begun to act. Law enforcement in Yavapai County has seized tens of thousands of counterfeit pills laced with fentanyl bound for our communities. MATFORCE has worked with over 30 substance use prevention coalitions from across Arizona in a first-of-its-kind effort to save lives in Arizona. Coalition leaders




# HEALING FIELD OF FLAGS

**This year marks the 20th Anniversary of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, on America.**

**What the Healing Field Means . . .**

Town Councilmember Mary Mallory spearheaded the effort to bring a Healing Field of flags to the Town of Prescott Valley in September 2012. That year, 1,200 flags flew at the Civic Center grounds. The community rallied behind the effort and in September 2013, 3,000 flags commemorated the lives lost in the Sept. 11, 2001, terrorist attacks.

It began as a simple way for one person to visualize and comprehend the sheer enormity of human loss that occurred in the terrorist attacks of September

11, 2001. But, as hundreds of volunteers gathered to help, it soon became evident that something much more was emerging. It became a personal gesture of support, a tangible expression of mourning, honor, and a very real healing experience.

Everyone is welcome to walk amongst the flags and read the bio tags. Salute, or pray or pay tribute for each person who is being represented by one of the flags. Count each of the boots, whether it be firefighters, police or military. Find each of the teddy bears on the flags of the children who perished

on the airplanes. Each flagpole bears information about the victims of the attacks. Many visitors have found the names of friends and family, and others have come to pay their respects to the victims and the first responders who gave their lives trying to rescue them.

**What are all the flags about?**

A tradition stretching over 8 years, Prescott Valley's Healing Field® display draws area resident of Northern Arizona together in a memorable and inspiring tribute to the victims of the terrorist attacks of September 11th of 2001.

This display of nearly 3,000 U.S. flags creates an atmosphere of optimism and healing, which must be experienced in
